As a culminating activity, we will bring in a local story teller, who will enchant our campers with fantastical stories from around the world!

School Policies, regulations and conditions:

1. The registration deposit must be paid before your child is officially enrolled in summer camp. **The registration deposit is non-refundable.** The remaining tuition will be due by April 1, 2012. Campers enrolled after April 1, 2012 will pay a 25% deposit, the remaining balance is due within 30 days of registration but no later than the child's first session date. All tuition is due by the child's first camp session. Changing or switching camp sessions is permitted but based on availability. 30 days written notice must be given for Camp withdrawal. A 75% tuition reimbursement will be given if the child's spot can be filled by the start date of that session.
2. We reserve the right to cancel camp sessions due to under-enrollment or other unforeseen circumstances. 100% of the tuition and deposit will be reimbursed if the camp session is canceled.
3. We reserve the right to dismiss a child with behavioral or health problems. This action will not be taken until the parents and the teacher have worked together to try to resolve the problem.
4. All required medical forms and immunization forms must be received by Potomac Nursery School before the first day of camp.
5. Potomac Nursery School does not practice or condone discrimination based on race, religion, color or national origin in the admission of pupils or the employment of faculty and administrative staff.
6. Potomac Nursery School reserves the right to make or change rules, restrictions and conditions are consistent with the safety, health and best interests of our students, faculty and families.
7. There will be a separate application for admissions to classes during the school year. This application does not guarantee admission during the school year.
